



The Nassau Wings Motorcycle Club along with the Amyloidosis Support Groups will present our Third Annual “**Freddy’s Run**” charity motorcycle event in 2017. In the years we've hosted this event (formerly known as Pop's Run) we've managed to raise over \$68,000 for the Amyloid Research Team at Boston University School of Medicine. This money has allowed them to purchase laboratory equipment and fund research for the causes and treatment of Amyloidosis. With the passing of our dear friend Freddy Peteani in March 2014 of Multiple Myeloma (*a sister disease to Amyloidosis*) we have renamed the event in his honor.

Amyloidosis is a group of diseases in which abnormal proteins accumulate in organs of the body and cause those organs to fail. The disease can affect the whole body and over 3,000 persons are diagnosed with it each year. The most common systemic type is a bone marrow disease that can be treated with chemotherapy and stem cell transplantation with favorable results; other types can be hereditary and new treatments are being developed for these. While great progress is being made in research toward finding more effective treatments and a cure, more work needs to be done. **Awareness is important** as early diagnosis allows patients to be eligible for the best treatment options.
